Proceeding of the XIII academic council meeting held on 9th June, 2017 as follows:

1. Read & confirmed the proceedings of the XII academic council meeting held on 28th July, 2016.
2. After thorough discussion and deliberations the members approved the syllabus for BCom I and II semesters with the introduction of Goods & Services Tax (GST) at I semester in place of Business Environment so as to give complete inputs on this new paper, as a result of introduction of GST in the nation, by abolishing Indirect Tax system.
It is also resolved to introduce a Certificate course in GST with Tally for BCom II semester level as mandatory course and honourable members suggested to conduct this course during II term for final year students.
It is further resolved to introduce 'International Business' in group 'D' in place of 'Economic Development' at BCom II semester.
3. Honourable committee's members have thoroughly discussed the recommended syllabi at BCA I & II semesters and approved unanimously the same with minor modification in Mathematics paper I & II and Numerical Methods subject.
4. After thorough discussion the honourable members approved syllabi at BBA II & IV semesters duly recommended by BOS, with introduction of MIL in English as additional subject as per the direction of RCU, Belagavi, and also some minor modification suggested in Quantitative Techniques subject.

It is further resolved to introduce Goods and Services Tax subject as specialisation group in place of Indirect Taxes at BBA VI sem from the academic year 2017-18.

5. After in detail discussion in the meeting it is unanimously approved the syllabi at MCom I duly recommended by BOS with the introduction of HRD in lieu of SHRM and on technical reason the BOS members expressed their view by interchanging IAFM subject of MCom IV sem. to MCom I sem. by shifting Principles of Financial Derivatives to MCom IV sem. It is further resolved to introduce G&T subject at MCom III sem. as specialisation subject in place of Indirect Taxes from the academic year 2017-18.

6. With the thorough discussion in the meeting the members unanimously approved the syllabi at MBA I and II semesters with various modifications suggested by BOS for the academic year 2017-18.

7. The academic Council discussed in detail regarding question paper pattern for numerical subjects at UG and PG level, where in it is resolved to approve the question papers with minimum 50% questions should be on numerical pattern.

8. The honorable committee members approved the panel of question papers setters and examiners for UG and PG programmes.

9. The Committee also suggested to update the policies for promotion of research and implementation
