





# XI Meeting of Board of Studies On 26<sup>th</sup> May, 2017

### Proceedings:

1. Read and confirmed the minutes of the last meeting.
2. After detailed discussion and due consideration for market demand, the BOS resolved to introduce the following course structure for BCom V Sem.

3. The Board decided to introduce the Goods & Services Act (GST) at BCom I Sem. in lieu of Business Environment subject. for the benefit of the students. The Board also discussed in detail regarding the various subjects at BCom II Sem. and resolved to continue the same subjects with some modifications and additions to the existing subjects. It is also approved the introduction of a Certificate Course in GST with Tally at BCom. VI Sem. This certificate course is made compulsory for all the BCom VI sem. students for which college is awarding a certificate for the same.

4. The Bös discussed in detail the question paper pattern for theory and numerical papers and accordingly approved the following question paper pattern.

BCom Programme - Question Paper Pattern.

Section - A

Answers any 8 out of 10 questions in one or two sentences each.  $(2 \times 8 = 16)$

Sec - B

Answers any 2 out of 4 questions.  $(5 \times 2 = 10)$

Sec - C

Answers any 3 out of 5 questions.  $(10 \times 3 = 30)$

Sec - D

Caselet: Answers any one out of 2 questions  $(14 \times 1 = 14)$

Total 70 marks

5. The BOs approved the new panel of question paper setters and examiners in all the subjects of BCom I to VI semesters and informed the principal to send the confidential panel of examiners to Examination section.

6. The principal briefed the members regarding mandatory attendance for students of 70% in each subject. In order to give benefit to those students who have attended more than 70% attendance will be given three marks in the following pattern and the same is approved

Slab %	Marks to be allotted
i) 70% - 79%	1 mark
ii) 80% - 89%	2 marks
iii) 90% and above	3 "
